ENROLLMENT FOR SPRING 2012

In order to more easily enroll students and reduce lines and waiting time, enrollment for Spring 2012 will follow this schedule:

November 7 - Monday	Seniors (91 or more hours completed)
November 8 - Tuesday	Juniors and Sophomores (31 - 90 hours completed)
November 9 - Wednesday	Freshmen (0 - 30 hours completed)
November 10 - Thursday	New Students for the Spring 2012

Anyone missing the designated day of enrollment may enroll any succeeding day (Monday – Friday) up through December 6. Regular enrollment will be January 6, 2012.

NOTE: Students enrolling in 3000-4000 level Education courses must bring their Admission to Teacher Education card or letter when they enroll, to verify that they have been admitted to the Teacher Education Program.

Withdrawals and Changes of Enrollment: Changes in schedules and complete withdrawals from the institution during the defined add-drop period will result in FULL charges for courses added and full credit for courses dropped. NO REFUNDS will be made after the add-drop period for that session.

IMPORTANT GRADUATION INFORMATION

Application for graduation in April 2012, should be completed in the Registrar's Office by **December 9, 2011**. The **last** day to apply for graduation for both Spring and Summer and participate in the Spring graduation ceremony is **February 3, 2012**.
