- SALARY & RANK:** Depending upon qualifications and experience.

- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The successful candidate will teach the mathematics and general education programs. Some courses may serve to fulfill curriculum requirements in the division of Education. Areas of instruction will include both lower and upper division coursework. This will include courses in pre-calculus, calculus, statistics, modern and linear algebra, differential equations. The individual will have responsibility for service on division and university committees including advising mathematics students, assisting with mathematics program committee work, program review, accreditation activities, and possible teacher education certification.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Ph.D. in mathematics or mathematics education required. Some college teaching experience preferred. An interest in team teaching in an interdisciplinary liberal arts program. A record of scholarly activities or demonstrated potential for such and experience in teacher education will be given additional consideration. Successful candidate must demonstrate a high degree of individual initiative and observe high standards of personal and professional integrity.
