RESPONSIBILITIES:

The selected candidate will teach one section of Stagecraft (3 credit hours plus lab time) and Theatre Production (3 hours lab).

The selected candidate may collaborate on production design and/or serve as the Production Manager for one main stage show in the fall term. They will collaborate with our Technical Director as needed on carpentry, lighting, sound, rigging, and projections while advising and mentoring student technicians and designers. Production schedule includes some nights and weekends.

The selected candidate may also collaborate with the Facilities Manager in the staffing and production of two visiting performances on the USAO campus.
