RESPONSIBILITIES:

The custodial staff is responsible for the daily cleaning of University buildings and equipment. Custodians are under the direct supervision of the Director of the Physical Plant. Typical routine duties include but are not restricted to- dust mopping, sweeping, wet mopping, vacuuming, dusting, waxing, cleaning restrooms, stripping floors, removing trash, polishing furniture, and operation of basic mechanical cleaning equipment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledge of cleaning methods, materials and equipment.
- Ability to perform manual tasks requiring moderate physical strength, lifting from 25-40 pounds, climbing, ladder work, crawling, overhead work, kneeling, walking and standing for extended periods.
- High School diploma or GED
- Willingness to work flexible schedule.
- Preference given to candidates with previous custodial experience.
