If you are unable to use the FAFSA's IRS DRT, you will need to request a "Tax Return Transcript" of your 2020 federal tax return from the IRS at <a href="irs.gov">irs.gov</a> or 1-800-908-9946. A signed copy of your 2020 Federal 1040 and accompanying schedules is also acceptable. If you file an amended tax return, a signed copy of your 1040X is required in addition to your IRS Tax Return Transcript or 1040. If you and your spouse filed separately, both IRS transcripts or 1040 forms must be provided. If you or your spouse file a tax return from Puerto Rico or other U.S. Territory/Freely Associated State, a signed copy of that tax return is acceptable documentation.

Students and spouses who report that they are not and are not required to file a 2020 federal tax return will be required to obtain an IRS "Verification of Non-Filing" letter dated on or after October 1, 2021. A Verification of Non-Filing letter can be obtained by using IRS form 4506-T and checking box 7.
